The course, taught in a friendly and stress-free manner, is aimed at the AGH UNIVERSEH kick-off meeting participants (administrative staff and teachers) who have never had any contact with the Polish language or whose knowledge of the language is low.

During the course you will learn how to pronounce Polish sounds correctly, especially those typical of the Polish language. You will learn basic polite expressions to facilitate communication and establishing contacts. You will be able to introduce yourself and briefly talk about yourself, as well as ask for basic information and conduct a short dialogue. The course will be followed by an interactive on-site session.


